

Project: Districtwide Touchless Technologies

Objective: Install touchless technologies throughout the district for virus mitigation.

Funding: ESSER I Funds

Status: Completed November 2020

Sturgis Public Schools installed the following touchless technologies as a virus mitigation strategy:

- 213 paper towel dispensers (new units)
- 315 soap dispensers (new units)
- 65 hand sanitizer dispensers (new units)
- 56 water bottle fill stations (new units)
- 178 sinks (new hardware on existing units)
- 73 toilets (new hardware on existing units)
- 39 urinals (new hardware on existing units)
